In March 2019, we had the following criminal incident in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:

Assault

On March 3, 2019, a domestic violence report was taken on Cawdor Way. The district attorney's office declined charges.

Auto Theft

On March 22, 2019, a resident of the Villages at Bunker Hill Apartments, reported that, sometime overnight, her van was stolen. The van was recovered on April 2, 2019 by the Houston Police Department and a suspect was arrested and charged.

Identity Theft

On March 20, 2019, a resident on Gaylord Drive reported his personal information was used to open a cable TV account in Florida.

Robbery

On March 19, 2019, an employee of the Villages at Bunker Hill Apartments, 970 Bunker Hill, reported that, at about 5:20pm, he was assaulted by a Hispanic male with a wooden board in an attempt to steal his vehicle. The male was later found by one of our officers near the library, arrested and charged with Aggravated Robbery.

On March 23, 2019, at about 12:30pm, a black male pointed a pistol at a homeowner on Dunbeath Drive and stole his vehicle. One of our officers spotted the vehicle and, after a short pursuit, arrested the suspect. He was charged with Aggravated Robbery.
